The Department of Psychiatric Social Work, NIMHANS invites applications for one month certificate course on 'Psychosocial care in Neurology'.

About the Course

Psychosocial care is essential in the toolkit of all professionals working with neurological disorders. Good psychosocial care also recognises the challenges to the professionals involved. The practice of psychosocial care needs to be founded on a secure base of knowledge, skills and values. Social work, as a profession, is committed to enabling and empowering individuals to achieve optimum level of functioning at the individual, family and community realms. To do justice to this commitment, there is a constant need to develop and update the body of knowledge as well as practice skills. This program is aimed to provide practical and theoretical exposure to build the capacity to deal with psychosocial dimensions of neurological conditions in the framework of palliative care, rehabilitation and disease management model. Through this programme, the students will receive case based learning, direct supervision and mentoring from faculty of various departments.

Course Learning Objectives: At the end of the course, the participant would be able to -

- ❖ Assess the array of bio-psycho-social issues in Neurological conditions
- ❖ Enhance the understanding of neuroscientific basis of psychosocial variables as well as therapeutics.
- ❖ Improve knowledge and skill in providing advanced psychosocial care in neurological disorders including palliative care and psychosocial genetic counselling.
- ❖ Reintegration into the community and long term psychosocial care plan for chronic neurological conditions.

Who can attend: Masters in Social Work, Health care professionals with masters level training with clinical experience obtained through a regular full time course from a recognized university. Students in the final year training of Social Work may also apply.

Duration: One Month full-time, on-campus.

Course dates: 1st- 30th April, 1st- 31st July, 1st – 30th September, 1st-30th November of 2018

The course of November 2018 is now open for application.

Number of Seats: Maximum 4 per intake in every batch.

Fee Payable: Rs.3000/- payable on selection (non-refundable)

Procedure for Application: The interested candidates should send their application on a plain paper along with the following documents:

1. Bio data with a recent passport size photograph and full postal address with email id and phone number.
2. Research and work experience related documents, if any
3. One page write up on why they want to pursue the training

Selection will be done based on the eligibility. If found eligible, the candidate will be informed of the same and asked to join.

Accommodation: The candidates need to make their own accommodation arrangements. Limited hostel accommodation may be offered only on prior request and is subject to availability-contact NIMHANS academic section upon selection.
